

# OBS COOKIES POLICY

This cookies policy (the "**Cookies Policy**") describes the different types of cookies or other similar technologies ("**Cookies**") that are used in connection with websites and apps (the "**Services**") managed by Olympic Broadcasting Services, S.L. ("**OBS**"). If you want to learn more about the personal information, we collect about you in relation to the use of our services please check our [Privacy Policy](#).

## 1. What are Cookies?

A cookie is a small file, stored on your browser or computer hard drive, which is used to collect data about your interactions with our website, such as browser type, operating system, IP address, browsing date and time.

Cookies are placed on your device by us ("first party cookies") or by third parties ("third party cookies"). These third parties include organisations that provide analytics and marketing services to us. The details of these third parties are listed in our Cookies Settings, which are made available when you first visit the Services and remain accessible on each subsequent visit to our Services.

## 2. Which type of Cookies are used in our Services

We use cookies and tracking technologies to remember your preferences and settings; to remember information that you may enter online; to keep you logged in to portals that we may offer; to generate aggregate statistics about how people use our website; for error management and troubleshooting; and to improve your experience of the website. Particularly we use the following types of cookies that we have categorised depending on their functionality:

- **Strictly Necessary Cookies:** These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in or filling in forms. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the site will not then work.
- **Performance and Analytics Cookies:** These cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our site. They help us to know which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors move around the site. If you do not allow these cookies we will not know when you have visited our site and will not be able to monitor its performance.



- **Functional Cookies:** These cookies enable the website to provide enhanced functionality. They may be set by us or by third party providers whose services we have added to our pages. If you do not allow these cookies, then some or all of these services may not function properly.

The details of the cookies for each category (session/persistent cookies, expiration time, cookies used, first or third party cookie) are available in the “[Cookies Preferences](#)” available in the footer of this website.

### 3. Expiration time

Cookies may be kept stored on your browser or computer hard drive for as long as you keep such browser active, for session cookies, or for a longer period, for persistent cookies. For more information see the cookies information available in our “[Cookies Preferences](#)” information, which are made available when you first visit our website and remain accessible on each subsequent visit to our services under the section “Cookie Settings”.

### 4. First party / third party cookies

Cookies are placed on your device by us (“first party cookies”) or by third parties providing certain services to us such as analytics (“third party cookies”). For more information see the Cookie list available to you when you first visit our websites and services and on each subsequent visit to our websites and services under the section “Cookie Preferences” available at the footer of this website.

Any data collected by these third-party cookies will be managed and controlled by these third-party providers according to their privacy policy. We do not control or have any access to these data. Please visit the websites of third-party providers to obtain further information on how they use cookies.

If you deny the use of all cookies (except the Strictly Necessary ones), neither non-strictly first-party cookies nor non-strictly third-party cookies will be used.

### 5. International Transfers

We may use cookies and technology services offered by companies located outside your place of residence and particularly outside EU/EEA. We adopt measures as required under applicable law to ensure any personal data collected as the result of such services will be given the relevant protection. While the personal data we collect will usually be processed in the European Union or in Switzerland (which provides a level of protection equivalent to the European Economic Area according to the Commission Decision of 26 July 2000), we may also transfer your personal data for the purposes allowed under this Cookies Policy some of which may be based in countries (like the United States of America) that do not provide in their laws for a level of protection of your privacy equivalent to the one applied within the European Union and Switzerland. Before transferring any personal data from the



European Union or Switzerland to other countries, we implement safeguard mechanisms recognized by European regulators such as standard contractual clauses. You can request a copy of any such safeguards in the address mentioned in this clause.

## 6. How do I manage cookies?

You have the possibility to disable all the cookies (except the Strictly Necessary ones) or manage them through the Cookies Preference button available at all times in the footer of our website.

Alternatively, and/or in addition, you can manage your cookie settings within your internet browser.
